- Language pedagogy, inclusive classrooms, and curriculum design
- · Visual culture, film, performance, and digital media
- Gender, sexuality, and the body in cultural production
- Environmental humanities, eco-criticism, and representations of place
- Creative writing, experimental forms, and new modes of expression

Accepted proposals will be notified during the first week of February.

GUIDELINES

For consideration, please submit an abstract or panel proposal through the 46th CCRALL Google Form. Accepted languages include Arabic, English, French, Italian, Portuguese, and Spanish.

Abstracts should be no more than 250 words, outlining your central questions and contributions.

Individual presentations will be limited to 20 minutes.

Panel proposals must include the title of your proposed panel, all the paper titles to be presented, their corresponding abstracts, and the names of the presenters. There is a limit of four papers presented per panel. All participants must submit their abstracts.

Roundtable proposals must include the title of the proposed roundtable, description, and participant names (up to 6).
